



Procedures for 2010-11 Association Representative Elections

To Association Representative:

April 2010

All San Diego Education Association Leadership positions are filled by election. Committee chairs are appointed. Active Members are eligible to hold or retain elective office in the San Diego Education Association (SDEA) as Association Leadership by membership vote. *Please hold elections for Site AR/CR for the 2010-11 school year and report your results to SDEA by **Friday, May 28, 2010.***

Basis of Representation:

1. Each site or cost center is allowed ONE Association Representative. Please refer to NUMBER OF ELECTED REPRESENTATIVES PER SITE on the back.
2. Additional Council Representatives are apportioned for each additional twenty (20) members or major fraction thereof, starting with the 31st member. Please refer to NUMBER OF ELECTED REPRESENTATIVES PER SITE on the back.
3. Each site or cost center is to have at least **one (1) Association Representative** and **one (1) Alternate**, regardless of size.

Nominations:

1. Nominations shall be taken at a site meeting or by written request. Notification of the date, time and intent to nominate must be provided to all site members at least **three (3) working days in advance.**
2. Opportunity shall be provided for **every member** to nominate or be nominated.
3. Self-nominations are acceptable.
4. Nominees for AR and/or CR **must** have been **members of SDEA for a minimum of sixty (60) calendar days** at the time of nomination.
5. **Members are eligible** to run for the positions of AR, CR or both.
6. A copy of these **Election Procedures shall be posted** on the SDEA bulletin board at least **three (3) working days** prior to nominations and remain posted until completion of the election.

Elections:

1. Names of all persons nominated shall be placed on the ballot.
2. A **sample ballot**, including a space for write-ins, shall be posted at least **three (3) working days** prior to the election.
3. Notification of the **date, time and place** of the election shall be given to all site members at least three (3) working days prior to the election.
4. Election shall be by a **secret ballot.**
5. The person(s) receiving the highest number of votes shall be considered elected.
6. Any **person running for office shall not conduct elections.** Any SDEA member may conduct the election.
7. All members shall **sign a registration sheet** before receiving a printed ballot.
8. **DEADLINE FOR RETURNING THE BALLOTS, TALLY SHEETS AND REGISTRATION SHEET (S) FOR THE ELECTION IS *Friday, May 28, 2010.***

What are the skills/duties of the AR/CR?

A. An effective AR/CR:

1. Knows how to motivate unit members to take part in the Association.
2. Knows how to run a meeting.

B. An effective AR/CR is a good communicator.

1. Solicits ideas & opinions from all the SDEA members frequently.
2. Maintains one-on-one contact.
3. Speaks out at visiting teachers/faculty meetings.
4. Maintains an on-site SDEA bulletin board.
5. Actively engages in 2-way communication between SDEA members & leaders.
6. Is an effective advocate between SDEA members and administration.

C. An effective AR/CR is a good organizer.

1. Recruits a cadre of people to help.
2. Knows how to get unit members to participate in union activities.
3. Understands how to unite SDEA members to build a position of strength.

D. An effective AR/CR is a decision maker.

1. Is willing to take action when problems arise at the site/program.
2. Knows when to file a grievance.

E. An effective AR/CR is assertive.

1. Continues to encourage non-members to join.
2. Is willing to handle grievances and problems at the site/program level.
3. Understands the grievance procedure.
4. Is willing and able to advocate for SDEA members on issues that may arise.

F. An effective AR/CR is a good manager of time.

1. Knows how to delegate responsibility.
2. Knows how to prioritize tasks.
