SDEA Wins Pro Rata Pay for Online PowerSchool Training

Last year, SDEA members were directed to participate in a mandatory training for the new PowerSchool software program. While some sites built the training into their professional development last year, many members had no option but to take an online training course outside of their workday. Members who participated in the online training were compensated at the workshop rate of pay of \$19.83 per hour.

This fall, SDEA notified the District that this violated our union contract, which states that the workshop rate of pay applies to members who participate *voluntarily* in a District-sponsored workshop. The PowerSchool training was not voluntary. The District has agreed to adjust the pay rate to pro rata. All impacted members' pay warrants will by adjusted by the end of the calendar year, and may have been adjusted already on the November pay warrant.

REMINDER: Retiring This Year? You Can Make Up Furlough Days.

Article 34: Furlough Days provides SDEA members who plan to retire in 2013-14 the option of working additional days during the year to offset the impact of the furlough days. For CALSTRS purposes, payments of days worked will be made to the employee's Defined Supplement Account.
